



DIRECTIONS FOR USE

For brush application to pruning wounds and grafting sealant on pomefruit, stonefruit and ornamental trees to reduce the incidence and extent of fungal invasion, including silverleaf and European Canker on pomefruit. For the prevention of Eutypa lata in grapevines. To give protection and seal grafts.

- 1. Shake thoroughly before use.
- 2. Never thin with water as product will not work.
- Apply thickly to dry wound surface or graft union with paint brush or applicator pack on the same day the pruning cut or graft is made.
- 4. DO NOTI apply to wounds or cuts showing extensive brown staining.
- 5. DO NOTI use on grapevines during the growing season (start of flowering to end of harvest).
- DO NOT apply on wet or foggy days as product won't dry. Apply on fine, sunny, windy days. Rainfast 4 hours after application.
- 7. Large wounds (>50mm diameter) on a main trunk would benefit from a second application.
- 8. Brushes should be washed out in water after use.
- 9. Reseal container after use to prevent skin formation.
