Vehicle	Switch off engine and electrical equipment. Keep people away and warn traffic. Check for spills/leaks. Call emergency services.
Spill	Slippery. Do not walk through spilled material. Stop leak if safe to do so. Contain spillage with sand or earth. Prevent product entering waterways, drains, and confined areas.
Fire	Material is combustible. Keep containers cool. Use foam or fog, do not use water jet. Product emulsifies – contain effluent and prevent entry to drains and waterways.

First aid actions

If Swallowed:	Do not induce vomiting. Obtain emergency medical attention.
If in Eye:	If splashed into eyes, immediately flush with water for at least 15 minutes or until irritation subsides. If irritation persists, call a physician.
If on Skin:	Remove any contaminated clothing and wash skin with soap and water.
If Inhaled:	Move to clean air and make comfortable in a position making breathing easy.
