Vehicle	Switch off engine and electrical equipment. Keep people away and warn traffic. Check for spills/leaks. Call emergency services.					
Spill	Wear overalls, chemical resistant boots and gloves (PVC), and safety goggles. Prevent further spillage or leakage. Absorb spilled product and place in a sealable container. Wash affected area with water detergent solution. Absorb washings and place in sealed container. Dispose of to an approved landfill or other approved facility.					
Fire	Call the Fire Service. Wear protective clothing including self-contained breathing apparatus. Toxic fumes may be released. Keep people away. Extinguish fires with foam, dry chemical, carbon dioxide or fine water spray. Cool other containers to prevent rupture. Contain run-off.

If on skin	Immediately wash affected area with soap and water. Wash contaminated clothing before reuse. Call a Doctor or National Poisons Centre for advice if irritation persists.					
If inhaled	Immediately move to fresh air and rest. Maintain half upright position if breathing is difficult. For advice call the National Poisons Centre 0800 764 766 or a Doctor if concerned.
