Vehicle Switch off engine and electrical equipment. Keep people away and warn traffic. Check for spills/leaks. Call emergency services.							
Spill	Exclude all bystanders from the vicinity of the spill and prevent material from entering waterways. Sweep up spill and place in waste container. Absorb liquid spills with an inert material (such as vermiculite, earth, sand) and place in waste containers. Wash area with water and alkaline detergent then absorb any remaining liquid with further inert material. Dispose of waste safely in an approved landfill						
Fire	Call Fire Service. Use dry chemical, foam, water spray or CO ₂ .						
First Aid actions:							
If swallowed	Call a POISON CENTRE or doctor/physician if you feel unwell. Rinse mouth.						
If in eye	Rinse cautiously with water for several minutes. Remove contact lenses if present and easy to do. Continue rinsing.						
If on skin	Wash with plenty of soap and water. Call a POISON CENTRE or doctor/physician if you feel unwell. If skin irritation occurs: Get medical advice/attention.						
If inhaled	Remove to fresh air and keep at rest in a position comfortable for breathing.						
Storage and Segregation Requirements							
General: Store locked up in a well ventilated place in the original container in a cool dry place, out of direct sunlight and away from stock feed, seeds, fertiliser or foodstuffs. Do not carry more than 0.5kg on a Passenger Service Vehicle.
