Vehicle	Switch off engine and electrical equipment. Keep people away and warn traffic. Check for spills/leaks. Call emergency services.					
Spill	Wear PPE: impervious gloves, eye protection, mask if necessary, waterproof hat, coat and trousers. Stop the source of the spill if safe to do so. Contain the spill to prevent further contamination of soil, surface or ground water. Do not allow material to enter sewers or bodies of water. Apply absorbent material and place in sealable container. Dispose of at approved landfill.					
Fire	Call Fire Service. Wear protective clothing including BA. Toxic fumes may be released. Keep unauthorised personnel away. Small fires: extinguish with dry chemical powder, CO ₂ , water spray or foam. Large fires: water spray, fog or foam. Do Not use full water jet. All run-off must be contained.					
First Aid Actions: Immediately call a POISON CENTRE or doctor/physician. If medical advice is needed, have product container or label at hand.						
If swallowed	Do not induce vomiting. Wash mouth with water. Give water to drink. Seek medical advice.					
If in eye	Rinse cautiously with water for several minutes. Remove contact lenses if present and easy to do. Continue rinsing.					
If on skin	Remove contaminated clothing and wash skin thoroughly with soap and water. Wash contaminated clothing before re-use. Seek medical advice if irritation develops.
